

**VILLAGE OF IRMA
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
BY-LAW 15-02**

A BY-LAW TO CONTROL LAND USE.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1, Sections 639 and 692(1) of the Statutes of Alberta 1994, every municipality must pass a Land Use By-law.

AND WHEREAS the Village of Irma Council deems it necessary to prepare a new Land Use Bylaw to effectively regulate land use within the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Irma, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Village of Irma Land Use By-law 15-02 is hereby adopted in accordance with attached Schedule "A".
2. That Village of Irma Land Use Bylaw 98-03, as amended, is rescinded in full.
2. That this By-law comes into full force and effect upon third and final reading.

Read a first time this 8 day of September, 2015.

Read a second time this 13 day of October, 2015.

Read a third time and finally passed this 13 day of October, 2015
